"The Four Miracles"

*"Now it was about the sixth hour,
and there was darkness over all the
earth until the ninth hour.*

*"Then, behold, the [2] veil of the temple
was torn in two from top to bottom; and
[3] the earth quaked, and the rocks were split,
and the graves were opened;

What we celebrate as "Good Friday" must have been "frightful Friday" for those witnessing the dramatic events that occurred during Christ's crucifixion. The events could not have gone unnoticed. Everyone knew that something significant had happened. We can only imagine how the people were affected.

The veil splitting in two must have devastated the priests who were undoubtedly working in the temple during the busy Passover week. The fact that it was torn from top to bottom reveals a total break with the Old Testament covenant. The New Testament stresses that it represents our free access to God. The barriers between God and man have been broken. Jesus is the new temple, and we live in the new age of salvation by faith.
